



Issue Update

Upcoming Projects for BCBC

BC Building Corporation (BCBC) implements capital projects as identified by other Social Capital Ministries, particularly the Ministry of Attorney General, Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General and, the Ministry of Children and Family Development. Recently, BCBC advised BCCA that it has the following ministry projects on its list up upcoming projects:

- Alouette River Correctional Centre Redevelopment \$12.2 million
- Fraser Regional Correctional Centre \$ 1.6 million
- Kamloops Regional Correctional Centre \$ 0.4 million
- Vancouver Island Regional Correctional Centre \$ 1.5 million
- CCTV Enhancements – 8 correctional centres \$ 2.5 million
- Various other restructuring projects \$ 3.8 million

According to BCBC, the Corporation is also concentrating on planning and implementing work arising out of the Government Accommodation Restructuring Initiative, which includes the downsizing of government and closure of courthouses and correctional facilities. Details of such work are not available at this time, however there will be small tenant fit-up projects spread across the province.

In addition there could be a number of operational/maintenance types of projects undertaken with an aggregate amount assigned in the range of \$5 million. However, these minor projects must go through further assessment and approval processes and therefore cannot be relied upon as definite at this time.

BCBC confirmed that the Corporation will continue to follow public tendering processes to ensure fair and competitive prices from the construction industry.
