



Issue Update

School Project Announced

The provincial government will be funding the construction of a new elementary school in the Cambridge area of Surrey. They have approved \$8.4 million for the project.

The funding comes under the government's 2004-2007 capital plan which indicates an allocation of \$722 million for a total of 66 schools over that time frame. The overall funding will include \$303 million for capital projects, \$330 million for general maintenance, and \$89 million for seismic upgrades.

The new Surrey school is expected to open to students in September of 2006.

Attention: Roofing Bid Depository Bidders

Bidders for roofing sections through Bid Depository (e.g. Section 07311 Asphalt Shingles or 07510 Built-Up Roofing) should be aware that if Section 07620 Metal Flashings and Trim is included in Bid Depository, it may under some circumstances duplicate what is already specified for flashings in the roofing section for metal flashings. This means that it is not necessary for a bidder to bid on Section 07620 in order to have a complete roofing bid that complies with the requirements for a RCABC warranty. Bidders for Section 07620 should also be aware that this section excludes all flashings other than roofing flashings.
